Hello Chief Savage,

Thanks so much for your patience, and for your continued interest in our Driver Feedback Signs. They are an excellent tool for behavior modification of speeding drivers. As discussed, our TC-600S has replaced the TC-500S, and offers these enhancements, for the same price as our TC-500:

- 13" display is 12% larger, giving drivers a better look at the display, now at 600 feet from the sign
- Full matrix display allows additional word alerts for speeders: SLOW DOWN, and TOO FAST
- WiFi connectivity allows any device with a web browser to communicate/operate the radar signs from a distance of up to 300 feet, 10 times the distance of the TC-500 Bluetooth connection
- There is even an option for a simulated camera flash, if you like

The TC-600S (solar) runs \$3600 plus shipping of \$150. For a quantity of 3 or more signs, you can expect a commensurate quantity discount.

Another option is to consider our turnkey bundle for the TC-600S, which we call "SAFETY IN A BOX". It includes a pole with crash tested breakaway base, anchor bolts for the cement pad, regulatory speed limit sign, and our data collection & reporting software, Streetsmart. I have attached a flyer for your review.

The single unit price for Safety in a Box is \$4200 plus shipping of \$240. If we palletize the shipment, there is a savings as well.

All of our signs include a 2 year warranty, and current lead time for shipping is 3 weeks from date of order. Our local distributor is Centerline Supply/Trantex, located in Houston. (281-448-7711)
