

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING  
OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS FOR LAKEVIEW POLICE DEPARTMENT  
FOR THE CITIES OF TAYLOR LAKE VILLAGE AND EL LAGO, TX  
HELD ON APRIL 14, 2014**

**CALL TO ORDER:**

1. Commissioner Bielat called the meeting to order at 6:31 p.m. with the above listed commission members present. The Pledge of Allegiance to the United States of America was recited.

**ADOPTION OF MINUTES:**

2. The minutes of March 17, 2014 were reviewed and a motion for approval was made by Commissioner Delly and second by Commissioner Wicks with all in favor the motion passed.

**DETECTIVE REPORT:**

5. Detective Dohr informed Commissioners that the burglary cases from the 14th, 15th and 17th have been closed after an arrest of a suspect. The cases were cleared while working with Seabrook on some similar cases. Commissioner O'Donel asked if it was a high school student and was informed it turned out to be an adult with an addiction problem. Commissioner Delley asked about the deaths during the month and Detective Dohr explained they were both due to natural causes. Commissioner Bielat inquired about the CPS case on Bellgrove and Detective Dohr explained to Commissioners there has been a procedural change when handling these cases at the Harris County DA's. Commissioners discussed the process with Detective Dohr.

**6. POLICE CHIEF'S REPORT:**

**6.1 Status Reports - Meetings, Personnel**

Chief Savage reported that he had conducted the Annual Bike Safety meeting at Ed White Elementary School. Chief Savage stated he attended the City Council meeting for Taylor Lake Village and will attend The City of El Lago's meeting later in the month. Chief Savage informed Commissioners that Sgt. King has been away for LEMIT training and should be finishing soon. He also stated that Sgt. Hendricks, Officer Newton and Officer Hayward are also scheduled for upcoming training in various fields. Chief Savage explained to Commissioners that some of the Department's computers will require upgrading. He said this may mean 3 or 4 computers will need to be replaced. Commissioner Delly stated the replacement computers will cost approximately \$700.00 per unit.

Commissioners agreed the financials are looking good so far for the year. Commissioner O'Donel commented that fuel expenses are down slightly.

**6.5 Speed Sentry Report - 800 Timbercove Drive**

Commissioners discussed the results of the Speed Sentry Report. Chief Savage advised that the Speed Sentry is placed where complaints are generated regarding speeding vehicles. Commissioner O'Donel feels this should be utilized at all times in the cities and maybe even have scheduled rotating locations.

**6.6 Upgrade Copier at Dispatch**

Chief Savage stated the fax is broken at the dispatch office. He feels it would be best to replace it with a printer/fax/copier/scanner. Commissioner Delly asked if it would be more cost effective to lease or purchase with a maintance agreement. Commissioner Delly motioned to purchase a new printer/fax/copier/scanner for the Lakeview PD Dispatch officer and Commissioner Wicks made a second with all in agreement the motion passed.
