

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING
OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS FOR LAKEVIEW POLICE DEPARTMENT
FOR THE CITIES OF TAYLOR LAKE VILLAGE AND EL LAGO, TX
HELD ON OCTOBER 19, 2020**

1. CALL TO ORDER:

6.1 Directed Initiatives Status Report - Detective, Code Enforcement, Meetings and Personnel:

Detectives report presented. Commissioner Delly inquired if the burglary cases were related. Chief Savage confirmed they were and committed by local juveniles. Charges have been filed in one case and the other burglary and theft cases are still being investigated. Chief Savage informed commissioners that the El Lago code reporting system is assessable to citizens to check and report violations. Commissioner Delly reported Taylor Lake Village has a similar system but not many people are aware of its existence. Commissioner O'Donel agreed and added possible reluctance from citizens.

6.2 Monthly Activity Report for September 2020:

Commissioner Easley inquired about Calls for Service in other jurisdictions at 18 percent. Chief Savage explained traffic stops are sometimes located in Pasadena or Seabrook city limits.

6.3 Financial Report through September 2020:

The department ended 2019-2020 fiscal year with a surplus. Audit should start the third week of November. Commissioner Easley inquired about uncleared checks from the reconciliation statement. Chief Savage addressed the same issue during previous audit and will address it again in November.




8. Adjournment:
