CERC's unincorporated division Texas Gas Operations engages in intrastate natural gas sales to, and natural gas transportation for, more than 1,420,500 residential, commercial, and industrial customers in over 200 communities in Texas. In 2004, approximately 99% of Texas Gas Operations' total throughout was attributable to retail sales and approximately 1% was attributable to transportation services. CERC's provision of gas and gas transportation services by necessity gives rise to numerous dealings in its service area with local governmental entities, as well as their employees and contractors. However, these dealings should not give rise to a conflict of interest because the terms and conditions for its services are set by tariffs approved by the cities in which we do business or the Texas Railroad Commission. Nevertheless, in the spirit of full disclosure, CERC provides on this form a description of its activities with local governmental entities.

There are many governmental entities in the service area served by CERC, including cities, counties and other governmental entities. In its normal course of providing gas and gas transportation services, CERC will regularly communicate with employees and contractors of local government entities, and in some instances is required to conduct business with such entities. For example, CERC has entered into franchise ordinances and street rental agreements with municipalities that, among other things, allow CERC to provide services in city rights-of-way. CERC pays municipalities a franchise fee for these rights. CERC on occasion may enter into other forms of agreements with local government entities in connection with its services; such as agreements relating to rights-of-way, Permits, and payment of taxes.
